Robert and Trevor flew back to South Bend, Indiana, to share Angels for Higher's program with Notre Dame's retail executives in their campus


boardroom. They prayed that God would bless their presentation, and the executives agreed to interview our candidate who had been recruited from the local Michiana Down Syndrome Association.


Notre Dame hired Heather to be their Greeter, and she is doing a wonderful job! Here's what one of her Managers said after her first day on the job:

They prayed God would bless their presentation and the executives agreed to interview candidates recruited with the help of the Down Syndrome Connection of the Bay Area.

Robert helped facilitate interviews between the candidates and Warrior personnel at Chase Center. The Warriors ended up hiring Ben, Matthew, William, and Sarah to work as Greeters at their arena this season!

Robert and Trevor make a presentation to all thirty Major League Baseball teams!

Robert and Trevor were invited to make a presentation at the 2019 MLB Security & Ballpark Operations Conference which was held at the Loews Hollywood Hotel in downtown Los Angeles. There were over seventy representatives (with at least one from each of the thirty MLB teams) in attendance during their talk in the largest meeting room of the hotel.

Robert and Trevor prayed God would grant them favor with the teams they spoke to at the Conference. Robert explained how hiring an Angels for Higher Greeter would promote diversity/inclusion throughout their cities, elevate the family-friendly brand of their stadiums, and lead to an astronomical public relations ROI to their teams.
